For the year of 2022, Veracyte, SAS reported an overall Gender Equality Index score of 99/100. The Gender Equality Index was introduced by the French government in 2018 and mandates that companies with 50 or more employees measure their performance against several pay equality indicators, with the government's stated goal of eliminating gender pay disparities in France. This index is calculated based on the following five criteria:
